Alumni Awards Guidelines

Preamble

1. The Alumni Association confers Alumni Awards each year. The Alumni Awards are intended to recognise eminent alumni of the University who have:
 - a) made outstanding contributions to the community;
 - b) stimulated ideas or services (creativity and innovation); and/or
 - c) shown exceptional dedication, creativity or leadership in their field of endeavour.

Eligibility

2. A person is eligible to be considered for an Alumni Award if:
 - a) the person is an alumnus of the University;
 - b) the person is nominated by another person; and
 - c) a nomination is submitted in accordance with paragraph 3 below.

Nomination Procedure

3. Nominations for Alumni Awards must be lodged with the Alumni Relations office at the UNSW Foundation in the Chancellery Building at the University by the closing date for nominations. Nominations must include:
 - a) a nomination form available from the Alumni Association website;
 - b) the name and contact details of the nominator and person nominated;
 - c) a curriculum vitae or summary of the professional and personal achievements of the person nominated; and
 - d) a supporting statement of up to 500 words by the nominator which addresses the following matters in relation to the person nominated:
 - i) outstanding contributions to the community;
 - ii) stimulation of ideas or services (creativity and innovation); and/or
 - iii) demonstration of exceptional leadership in their field of endeavour.

Determination of Awards

4. Each year the Alumni Awards Committee shall, from among the nominations received, select and recommend to the Board persons who should receive Alumni Awards. There are four broad categories: Business and Commerce, Arts, Science, and Community at large.
