The Sexual Harassment and Discrimination Legal Service is a specialist NSW service of Kingsford Legal Centre (KLC). KLC is a community legal centre that gives free legal advice and casework assistance to people who have experienced discrimination and live in New South Wales.

We can also provide free legal education sessions to organisations and community groups.

What is sexual harassment?

Sexual harassment is any unwelcome sexual behaviour that is offensive, humiliating and intimidating.

It can happen anywhere, online or in person. Most importantly, it's against the law.



Examples of sexual harassment include:

- > Staring, or leering
- > Unwelcome touching
- > Suggestive comments or jokes
- > Unwanted requests for dates or sex
- > Intrusive questions about your private life or body
- > Emailing pornography or rude jokes, or putting sexual images around the workplace
- > Sending or posting sexual content through social media or text message
