Program and Course Terminology

Terminology	Definition
Disciplinary Component	Students must complete 168 UOC (28 courses) of Core Courses, Built Environment Electives and Prescribed Electives to satisfy the Disciplinary Component of the program.
Core Courses	Students must complete 144 UOC (24 courses) across Level 1, Level 2, Level 3, and Level 4 Core Courses.
Built Environment Electives	Students must complete 12 UOC (2 courses) in Built Environment Electives.
Prescribed Electives	Students must complete 6 UOC of History & Theory, and 6 UOC of Digital Technologies Prescribed Electives.
Free Electives	Students must complete 12 UOC (2 courses) of Free Electives.
General Education	Students must complete 12 UOC (2 courses) of General Education courses in line with UNSW General Education Rules.
Thesis Electives	There is an option in Year 4 to undertake a thesis. Students may substitute the Thesis for 12 of open elective credit. To qualify for the thesis, students must have an overall WAM of 70 and submit an application to the Program Director by the end of Year 3.
Overall Program UOC	Students must complete a 192 UOC (32 courses) across Core, Built Environment Electives or Optional Minor, Free Electives and General Education courses to fulfil program requirements.

Students admitted to the Bachelor of Landscape Architecture (Honours) (BLA (Hons)) who have completed one of the following diplomas are eligible for credit transfer:

Credit will also be considered for students who have completed a TAFE qualification that supersedes one of the above. Additional RPL may be requested on a case-by-case basis.
