**\*\*Professional Placement (EDST6760 and EDST6765):**

- Students are only permitted to enrol in the **main term offerings**. LANTITE must be completed before enrolling in EDST6765 (**register via the ACER website**).
- Students must meet the NESA Mathematics requirements. Students not meeting the requirements must take TAFE Statement of Attainment in Mathematics and Statistics bridging unit before enrolling in EDST6765.
- Students must be available full-time (5 days per week) for 4 weeks for EDST6760 (Year 1, T2A) and full-time (5 days per week) for 9 weeks for EDST6765 (Year 2, T1 or T2C).
