Students wishing to graduate with a City Analytics or Urban Design specialisation should choose their electives from those listed under the specialisations. Refer to the Handbook for the list of prescribed electives, including specialisations, and term offerings. Sustainability core course SUSD0004 Sustainability and Habitability, offered in Term 3, is an accepted equivalent to SUSD0001. This also gives more flexibility on elective choice. Capstone options Students can only enrol in PLAN7149 Planning Thesis or UDES0002 Urban Design Studio after successful completion of 60UOC. Only students completing PLAN7149 should enrol in BENV7020.
