	<p>1. Prescribed Electives: Students must select four elective courses (24 UOC) from the Prescribed Elective list and can complete them in any term, not just as shown above. Students wishing to graduate with a City Analytics or Urban Design specialisation should choose their electives from those listed under the specialisations. Refer to the Handbook for the list of prescribed electives, including specialisations, and term offerings.</p>
	<p>2. Sustainability core course: SUSD0001 Sustainable Development & the Urban Environment, offered in Term 1, is an accepted equivalent to SUSD0004. This gives flexibility on elective choice.</p>
	<p>3. Capstone options: Students can only enrol in PLAN7149 Planning Thesis or UDES0002 Urban Design Studio after successful completion of 60UOC. Only students completing PLAN7149 should enrol in BENV7020. Students completing UDES0002 Urban Design Studio must complete different prerequisites. Refer to the Handbook for details.</p>
<p>4. New semester calendar: 24UoC will be considered a full semester load in 2028. Students wishing to complete their degree in one semester in 2028 should consider completing an additional elective earlier in their program.</p>
