Terminology	Definition
Program compulsory core & flexible core courses	Courses which students must complete under their enrolled degree e.g. Bachelor of Commerce/ Computer Science 3967
Commerce Major	A sequence of approved courses (48UOC) in an approved discipline stream offered by the UNSW Business School (See Appendix A.), containing at least 18UOC at level 3. (Note that the 48UOC includes the first disciplinary course(s) in the Core (Compulsory or Flexible). This means that, for the majority of majors, students will complete 42UOC in specified disciplinary courses outside the core, except for the Real Estate Studies major.)
	For any majors that require ECON1202, MATH1011/MATH1031/MATH1131/MATH1141/MATH1151 completed under the Computer Science component will act as substitute so student should not do ECON1202 but instead complete another Major elective to meet the 48UOC requirement.
UNSW Business School Elective	Account for 12 -18UOC (2 - 3 courses). Students have a minimum of 6UOC of UNSW Business School electives to complete due to the ECON1203 requirement being fulfilled by MATH courses within the BCompSci component. Any remaining credit requirements within the B Com component (a total of 96UOC must be completed) must be taken in courses offered by the UNSW Business School.
