THESE STUDENTS WILL NEED TO COMPLETE THE COURSE REQUIREMENTS OF CPA AUSTRALIA OR CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND (please refer to the CPA or CA websites, noted below, for the requirements of the two bodies) AND ADDITIONALLY COMPLETE TWO 6 UOC ECONOMICS COURSES AT LEVEL 2 OR ABOVE. ONE LEVEL 2 ECONOMICS COURSE MAY BE TAKEN AS THE COMMERCE ELECTIVE, WHILE THE SECOND LEVEL 2 ECONOMICS COURSE MAY NEED TO BE TAKEN ON A NON-AWARD BASIS. |

Apart from the required CPA/ CA ANZ required courses, students will need to complete 12uoc of Economics courses at level 2 or above. One level 2 Economics course may be taken as a Business School elective, while the second level 2 Economics course may need to be taken on a Non-Award Basis; Summer semester; or overload in final year.
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
