Program and Course Terminology

Terminology	Definition
Compulsory Core Courses	Students must take 48 UOC of the integrated first year courses and 12UOC of international depth courses
Commerce Major	Major Requirements: 48 UOC in an approved disciplinary stream containing at least 18 UOC at level 3. Note that the 48 UOC includes one course from the Integrated First Year. This means that students will complete 42 UOC in specified disciplinary courses outside the core.
	One course within the major is to be in the international-labelled course in the relevant discipline, such as: ACCT3601, ECON2111, ECON2322, ECON3104, ECON3116, FINS3616, FINS3650, TABL2756, TABL2790, TABL3791, MARK2071, MGMT2101, MGMT2102, MGMT3102, MGMT3701
Focussed International Studies	24 UOC of courses in the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences (FASS), which must be taken within ONE area of: Asian Studies, Development Studies, European Studies, Globalisation Studies, International Relations, Language Studies, Politics History
	Students with free electives available may use their free electives to complete a major or minor in their chosen Focussed International Studies area.
Studies of the region	12 UOC of Studies of the Region courses are to be completed as part of the 48 UOC completed while undertaking the compulsory 1 year exchange at an overseas institution. Students may complete COMM6512 or two COMM6513 courses to meet this requirement. Approved Studies of the Region courses must relate to the country or region of the COP (Commerce Overseas Program) placement - for example, language of the region, history of the region, geography of the region, politics or business practices of the regions - or be international or global in nature The Studies of the Region courses need to be approved by the UNSW Business School Student Centre . To proceed on the Commerce Overseas Program (COP) students must have achieved satisfactory academic progress in their first and second years of study and must fulfil the requirements of the University's Exchange Program.

Business School Electives	Students must take Business School Electives to complete a minimum of 108UOC (18 courses) of courses within the Business School. Students are free to use these UOC to complete a second Commerce major or minor, however they need to be mindful of the program level 1 limit when making their selection. GEN courses cannot count as Business School Electives.
Free Electives <u>OR</u> Second Major OR Minor	Students can take up to a maximum of 36 UOC of the following courses. Students are free to use these UOC to complete courses from any Faculty or to complete a second Major or a Minor. However, they need to be mindful of the program limit on Level 1 courses (60 UOC) when making their selection. NOTE: GEN coded courses cannot count as a Free Elective. Student undertaking certain double majors may not have any free electives.
Double Majors	Students completing a major sequence with courses in common which are not integrated 1st year course may only count the overlap towards one major and must replace this course within the other major with a major elective of the same level or higher.
myBCom International	Students need to complete three non-credit bearing myBCom professional development elements including myBCom Blueprint (COMM0999), myBCom First Year Portfolio (COMM1999) and myBCom Graduation Portfolio (COMM3999)
Mandatory WIL course	Students must complete a 6 UOC Work Integrated Learning (WIL) course within their program. This course can count as a free elective or where applicable, can count as a Commerce major elective or Final Year Synthesis.
Final Year Synthesis	Students must complete either a 6 UOC Synthesis of Learning Course, or a 0 UOC Synthesis Experience.
	Students who complete a Synthesis course that is also a Work Integrated Learning course within a major will meet a major elective, WIL and Synthesis requirement.
Level 1 limit	The maximum level one limit in this degree is 84UOC (14 courses)
Overall Program UOC	Students must complete a minimum 192 UOC (32 courses) across program requirements.
