PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- **48 UOC**: Integrated First year
- **84 UOC:** Co-op Specialisation major 48 UOC disciplinary courses plus 36 UOC Industry Training. Must contain at least 18 UOC at level 3. Completion of Industry Placement 3 will also meet Final Year Synthesis program requirements for BCom.
- 12 UOC: Free Electives maximum number of "any course". Students may choose to complete an optional second major/minor using these
- 12 UOC: General Education: Students must take at least 12UOC of General Education courses outside their faculty.
- **COMM0999, COMM1999, COMM3999:** myBCom: Students must take all 3 components of myBCom at the specific stages of their program to successfully meet program requirements.

Notes:

- This is a **SAMPLE study outline only** and can be subject to change.
- The order of Integrated First Year courses can change but FIN Co-op scholars should complete FINS2618 in T3 of 1st year prior to IT1.
- You must always take your Industry Training schedule into consideration when planning your course enrolment or other commitments (see diagram below).
- You must satisfy the Bachelor of Commerce single major requirement in Finance and Gen Ed requirements per the UNSW Handbook.
- All students must ensure they meet the degree requirements/complete the core courses outlined in the UNSW Handbook.
- Student must note the Min/Max Level 1 subjects / Level 2,3 and 4 Maturity Requirements and excluded courses for Co-op scholars.
- Students completing the single major in finance must choose 7 courses in Finance Level 1-3 and ECON3203 **OR** FINS3646
 Honours must include core courses FINS4774, FINS4776, FINS4777, compulsory thesis FINS4796, FINS4797, FINS4799 and one elective from either FINS4779, FINS4792. (**NB.** timing and structure of the Finance Honours can change and should be clarified with the School).
- FIN Co-op scholars who wish to undertake Hons **must** refer to the Hons Study outline / Handbook major FINSBH and in addition to the requirements of the 3554 Commerce (Co-op) degree ensure they have sufficient performance in Finance courses to-transfer to the Hons program at the end of 3rd year

Note on Exchange: Exchange recommended in 2nd year T3.
