- Treat all students, staff and participants with professionalism, respect and courtesy.
- Comply with applicable health, safety and security requirements while attending the event.

Event Participation

To support the successful delivery of events, participating organisations agree to:

- Respond to reasonable requests for information and planning discussions.
- Provide requested content or promotional materials by agreed deadlines.
- Notify UNSW Employability as soon as possible if attendance arrangements change.

Cancellations

Places at UNSW Employability events are limited. If you need to cancel your participation, please notify the Employability team at employability@unsw.edu.au as soon as possible. Cancellations received less than **14 days** before an event may result in the forfeiture of any applicable participation fee.
