

3.7 Graduate Studies

The School of Surveying in 1992 offered five courses of graduate study:

- Graduate Diploma
- Master of Surveying Science (*by course work*)
- Master of Surveying Science in Land and Geographic Information Systems (*by course work*)
- Master of Surveying (*by research*)
- Doctor of Philosophy

The Master of Engineering Science (Remote Sensing), by course work, is offered to students doing a substantially remote sensing program through the Centre of Remote Sensing and GIS.
