UNSW Uni Prep Course Components

Term 1

University Orientation & Study Skills 1 (REGZ9000)

Teaching Format

1 x 1 hour lecture per week (1 hour total)

1 x 2 hour tutorial per week (2 hours total)

This course is a foundational academic skills course that covers reading, writing, planning, speaking and researching. It focuses on generic academic skills and uses essay writing as a basis for course design and assessments. While it is an academic skills focused course, the theme will be Technology.

Social Science Skills (REGZ9077)

Teaching Format

1 x 1 hour lecture per week (1 hour total)

1 x 2 hour tutorial per week (2 hours total)

This course is an introduction to fundamental skills in Social Sciences, including both key concepts and practical application. It will only be offered for students in the Arts, Design, Architecture & Criminology stream.

Term 2

University Orientation & Study Skills 2 (REGZ9255)

Teaching Format

1 x 1 hour lecture per week (1 hour total)

1 x 2 hour tutorial per week (2 hours total)

This course focuses on discipline specific academic skills. It is based on report writing and a short research project, including topics on sustainability, incorporating interdisciplinary perspectives.

ADAC Faculty Electives

In Terms 2 and 3, students will have the chance to study faculty elective courses. Please refer to the UNSW handbook for course descriptions.

Faculty Electives

Students who take the full-time option have the chance to study faculty elective courses in Term 2 and Term 3.

Some courses may change depending on availability.

Students may also take a course outside this list based subject to the approval of the program authority.
