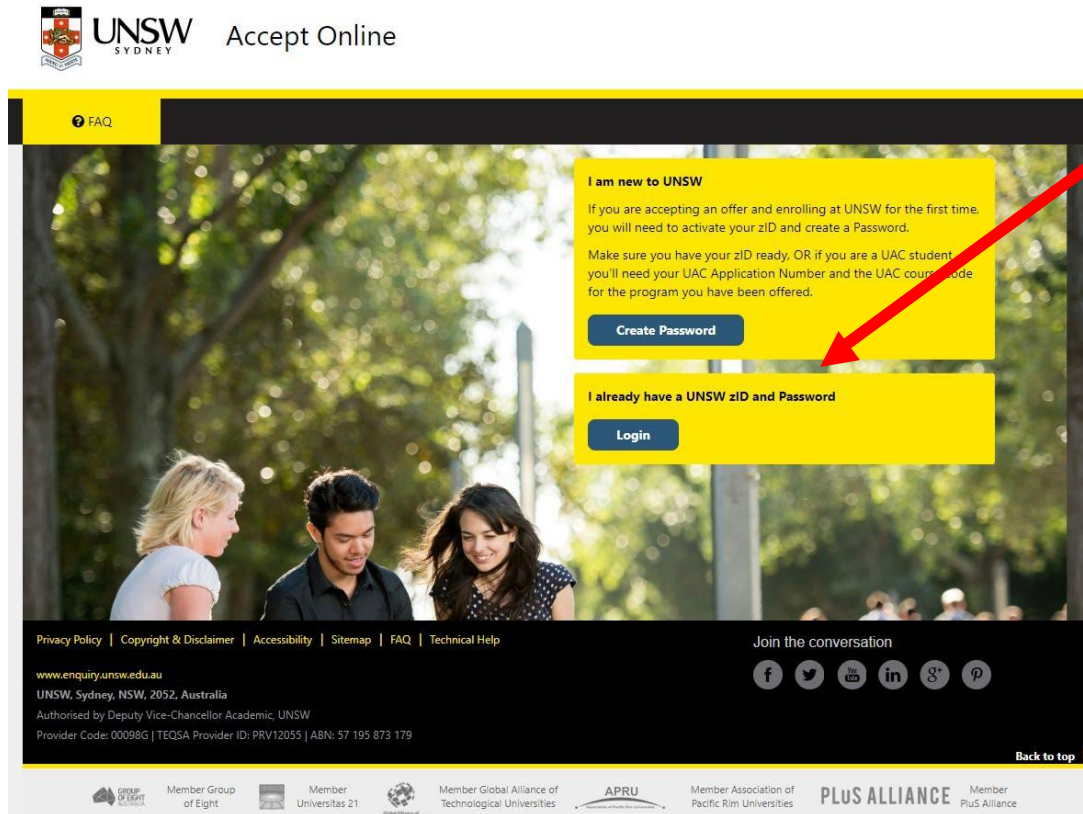
Sponsored Student Offer Acceptance

Sponsored students are international students who receive funding to study at UNSW from an approved sponsor organisation. Sponsorship may cover tuition and/or living expenses and travel costs, depending on the agreement.

Once a sponsored student holds an offer to study at UNSW Sydney, they are required to accept that offer in a different way to non-sponsored students.

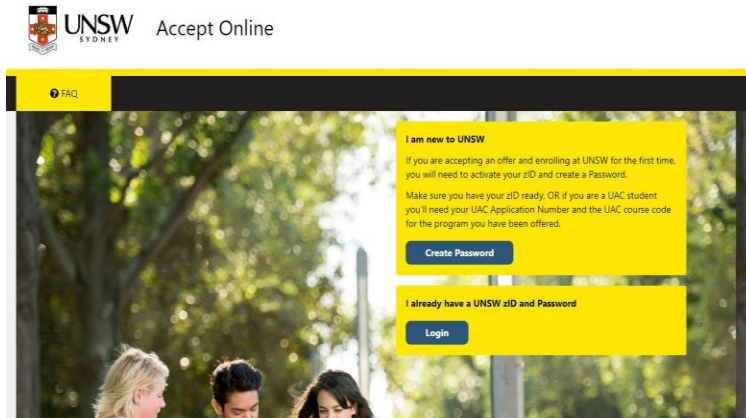
As a first-time user you will have to create a password via the Identity Manager website <https://iam.unsw.edu.au/home>.

Follow the steps in the UNSW Identity Manager portal, ensuring you fill in your details accurately.

Your student ID is available on your offer letter.

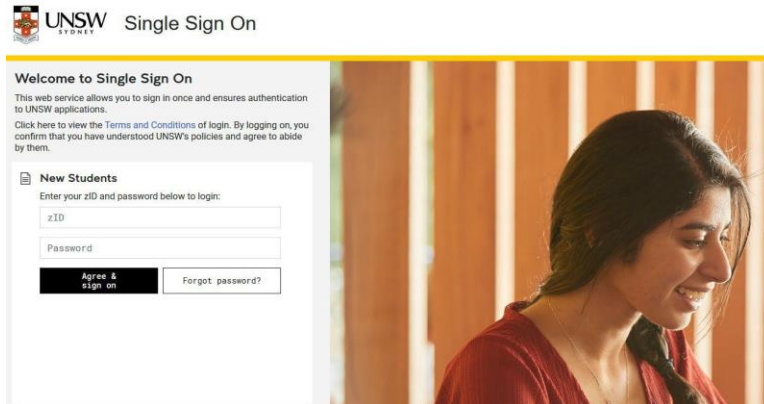
Date of Birth, Student ID and the Program Code must be the same as on the offer letter.


