Content Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Foster the power of storytelling: Engage the audience with a compelling narrative.• State the impact: Clearly articulate the significance and potential impact of the idea.• State the 'what if we don't': Highlight the consequences of inaction.• Wrap up with 'imagine this': Inspire the audience with a vision of the future if the idea is implemented.
Structure Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Engaging presentation: Maintain audience interest throughout the pitch.• Excellent video quality: Ensure professional visual and audio quality.• Less than 5-minute video: Keep the presentation concise and within the time limit.
