#### Decision Making Flow

University Committee recommendations on academic programs, policy and quality go to Academic Board.

Minor revisions (Level 1 & 2) are approved by the ADE.

Level 3 revisions are reviewed by the Faculty Qualifying Degrees and Postgraduate Education Committees and then sent to the Faculty Board for a decision.

Level 4 & 5 revisions are reviewed by the Faculty Qualifying Degrees and Postgraduate Education Committees and then go to Faculty Board and some to University Committees.

Faculty Assessment Review Group reports directly to the Academic Quality Assurance Committee.
