Discrimination happens when someone treats you unfairly in an area of public life because of:

- > Your gender
- > Your race
- > Your sexuality
- > Your disability
- > Pregnancy
- > Caring or family responsibilities
- > Transgender status
- > Your age

Discrimination law is complex and covers lots of characteristics. Not all unfair treatment is discrimination.
