How we help

In 2017 we worked with more than 2,500 people seeking asylum:

- 725 were children
- 1,014 were new to the Centre
- From over 80 countries

People arrived by plane and by boat.



Challenges faced by people seeking asylum

People seeking asylum demonstrate great resilience and also face serious challenges.

The process of applying for protection is lengthy and uncertain - some people wait years for a decision.

During this time, many:

Face financial hardship
Struggle to afford accommodation
Lack legal assistance
Become socially isolated
May not be able to find a job
May have to reapply for Medicare
regularly.



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Our Health service


Our Health service provides:

- General medicine and nurse led clinics.
- Physiotherapy.
- Prescription medicines.
- Fortnightly optometry clinic.
- Fortnightly family planning clinic.
- Referrals for specialised counselling and dental clinics.

During 2017 we provided 2,510 health assessments and 1,025 pharmaceutical prescriptions.



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
