Planning for social inclusion

- Embedding social inclusion in land use planning
- Accessible neighbourhoods: Inner West Inclusion Action Plan
- Facilitating inclusion in mainstream activities eg Gig buddies







Policy

- Inner West Affordable Housing Policy
 - Addressing absence of affordable housing for essential workers and others in the inner west
 - Targets and value capture to increase affordable housing stock
 - Provides strong basis for negotiations with developers



Partnerships addressing homelessness

- Multi agency outreach teams in Ashfield and Newtown hot spots and annual street counts
- Partners: Health Sydney LHD (mental health practitioners); FACS (Housing staff); Mission Australia; Exodus; Newtown Neighbourhood Centre; Partners in Recovery;
