

Grad Dip in Orientation and Mobility 5420 - T1 2026 START

Students must complete 48 UOC when taken as a standalone program. This is an intensive full-time program. Only in exceptional circumstances will students be allowed to enroll in a reduced program. Students should take all courses in sequential order.

Please Note:

- VISN5523 Orientation and Mobility in Practice is taken twice across two terms for a total of 12 UOC.
- Students will need to demonstrate competence in the initial blind mobility skill set and visual strategies, and demonstrate the mechanics of teaching them (practical components in VISN5512 and VISN5521) before commencing a work integrated (WIL) learning placement.
