	<b>Additional Information:</b> Students commencing via the Graduate/Lateral Entry pathway must have completed PHCM9041: Foundations in Public Health & Health Care and MFAC1601: Introductory Clinical & Communication Skills as part of the 4500 Science (Honours) program.
	To note- Under the BMed/MD 3805 program, MFAC2510 is a <i>Graduate Entry Bridging</i> course for Lateral Entry students. During their 1st year of studies, the Graduate/Lateral entry students will be joining the UNSW year 3 & 4 cohorts in their courses/exams. From their 2nd year they will join the Phase 3, year 5 & 6 student cohorts in completing the program.
