

# Sensory Guide

## Sound

Most of the time, the museum is fairly quiet. The TV in Bay 9 plays videos at a moderate volume. The hand dryers in the toilets are quite loud.

## Lighting

The museum is well-lit, with consistent lighting all the way through.

## Smells

There are no strong smells in the museum itself. Occasionally, smells from the food court nearby can come in through the air conditioning.

## Temperature

The museum is kept at a temperature of around 22 degrees Celsius.

## Crowds
