


# Key findings from the NSW Illicit Drug Reporting System interviews, 2018




Annual cross-sectional interviews from 2000 to 2018 with people who inject drugs, recruited from Australian capital cities



## High frequency use in the past six months



## Drug of choice




## Use in the past six months




## Risks and harms

- 25%** of the NSW sample reported experiencing a non-fatal overdose in the last year
- 61%** had heard of take-home naloxone programs
- 11%** had been resuscitated by someone who had participated in a program



## Main current treatment type



- Borrowed needles
- Lent needles
- Shared other equipment
- Re-used own needle
