## Placement programs

Optometry students in their final two years of study at UNSW Sydney participate in several placements.

Our final year students have the opportunity to travel within Australia or overseas to participate in a four-week Stage 5 Preceptorship program placement. They also complete a six-week private practice placement within Greater Sydney.

Our students in their penultimate year of study may complete a two-week Stage 4 Preceptorship program placement in rural or regional Australia.

- All students have obtained a National Police Check Certificate showing they have no history of criminal offences or have been approved by NSW Health by commencement of placement.
- The University cannot require students to use their own vehicles for placement tasks as this is not covered by University Insurance. If this is an issue for your practice please contact Michelle Bonanno.
