Built on the foundation of our strong Co-op Scholarship Program, stand-alone Co-op Internships can fill short-term project or resource gaps; recruit for a specific opportunity; trial alternative Co-op Program streams on an as needs basis, while providing invaluable learning & professional development opportunities for UNSW students.

The UNSW Co-op Program offers Industry Partners additional support in the form of stand-alone internships.

Internships provide access to high-quality UNSW students, across a variety of program streams & Faculties who can provide invaluable additional resource on projects, raise your organisation's profile and/or build stronger partnerships with UNSW.

Internships allow Industry Partners to explore different program streams for potential future sponsorship and are designed specifically to provide companies with agile, scalable resource.

Indicative timing and duration for internships

Stand-alone internships are usually 12 or 24 weeks, other durations can be discussed at a pro-rata cost. Internship timing can be flexible, but must work within UNSW Terms.

Internship Duration	Industry sign-up date	Internship Cost
Dec – mid-Feb (12 weeks)	mid-October	\$11,200 + GST
Jan – June (24 weeks)	mid-October	\$22,000 + GST
June – Dec (24 weeks)	mid-March	\$22,000 + GST

Invoicing

Invoices are only issued following appointment of a successful candidate. Should a suitable candidate not be identified during the recruitment phase, Industry Partners can cancel the internship at no charge or postpone the internship.

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
