

Pathways

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What are pathways?

A pathway is a recommended course progression plan designed by your program authority. Students in their first year can find recommended pathways to apply to the planning tool in myPlan. Once applied, a pathway will provide guidance on courses to enroll in your first year of study, including important academic notes and general course progression advice.

For most pathways the top section contains general notes relevant to your program such as required courses or course alternatives due to full classes.

Pathways

This is intended as a guide only and does not replace the program requirements as stipulated in the [handbook](#). Courses do not need to be studied in the exact structure that they appear here. This pathway is for students wishing to complete a double Major.

You must complete:

- 48 UOC Major courses
- 36 UOC Free electives
- 12 UOC General education courses
- 48 UOC second Major courses

There are also other options available to you, which you can use the remaining 48 UOC and your Free Electives to complete: Major & Minor, Double Major & Minor and Major & Double Minor. You may also complete a triple Major using a third major from outside the ADA Faculty, and student who choose this option are not required to take General Education courses.

Major courses, Free Electives, and General Education courses are not offered every term - please plan accordingly. These courses can be taken in any term which has capacity and not necessarily in the term specified in the sample pathway.

If a student applies a pathway to their planner, they are still required to log into MyUNSW to complete official enrolment. MyUNSW can import choices from the planning tool, to help students complete their enrolment. For guides to import courses from myPlan in MyUNSW please see the following [link](#).

Students must enrol in courses via myUNSW and declare any specialisation in myUNSW. Selections in myPlan **WILL NOT** appear on your official record.

How to choose a pathway

Every program has a pathway that can be added in myPlan to help with your progression planning. By using the quick add function (page 5) in myPlan you will only see the pathways available to you in your program for your entry year. Students choose their pathway based on the term they are starting.

For example, if you are starting in term 1 choose the pathway with T1 in the title.

e.g. Bachelor of Laws, 3375, T1 2026 START

If you find that your list of possible programs has multiple choices that include specialization options

e.g.

Bachelor of Laws, CRIMC1, 3375, T1 2026 START

or

Bachelor of Laws, SOSSB1, 3375, T1 2026 START

It means you need to determine your specialization choice before applying your pathway. Refer to your program entry in the [handbook](#) for rules on specialization choices. Remember you can “try on” a pathway and specialization in myPlan and remove those choices at any time.

To plan a specialization simply navigate to your progress tab and add in the specialization choice. You can always remove later if you want to “try” different combinations. **Once you have made your final decision make sure you formally declare your specialization in myUNSW.**

There are two ways to choose a pathway:

1. Recommended Pathways – myPlan Homepage

After signing into myPlan, relevant pathways appear on the homepage. Select these pathways to see guidance information and to apply to the planner. 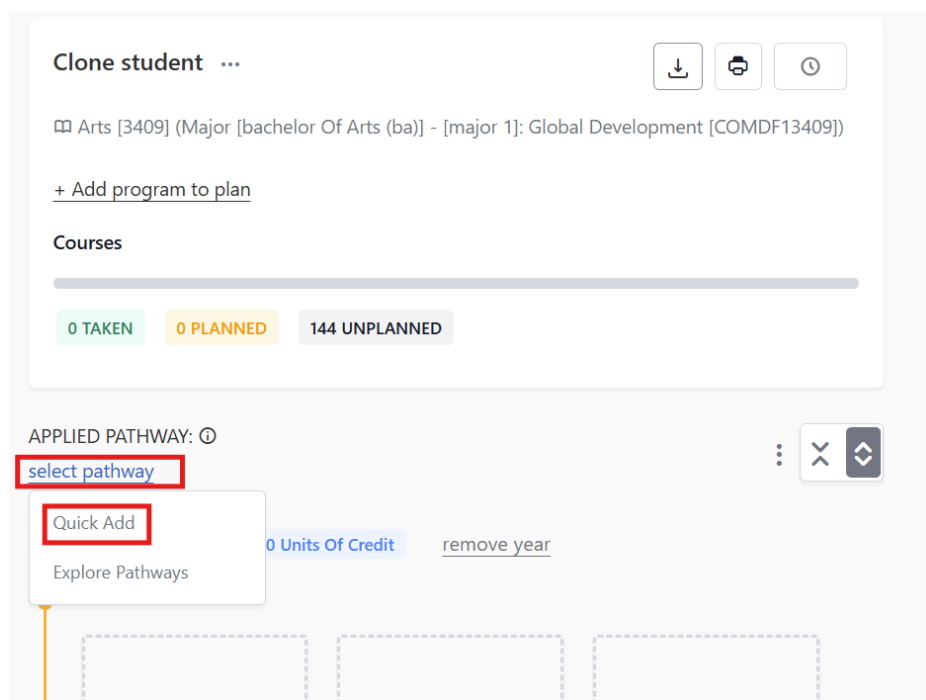

2. Using the Quick Add function in the Planning Tool

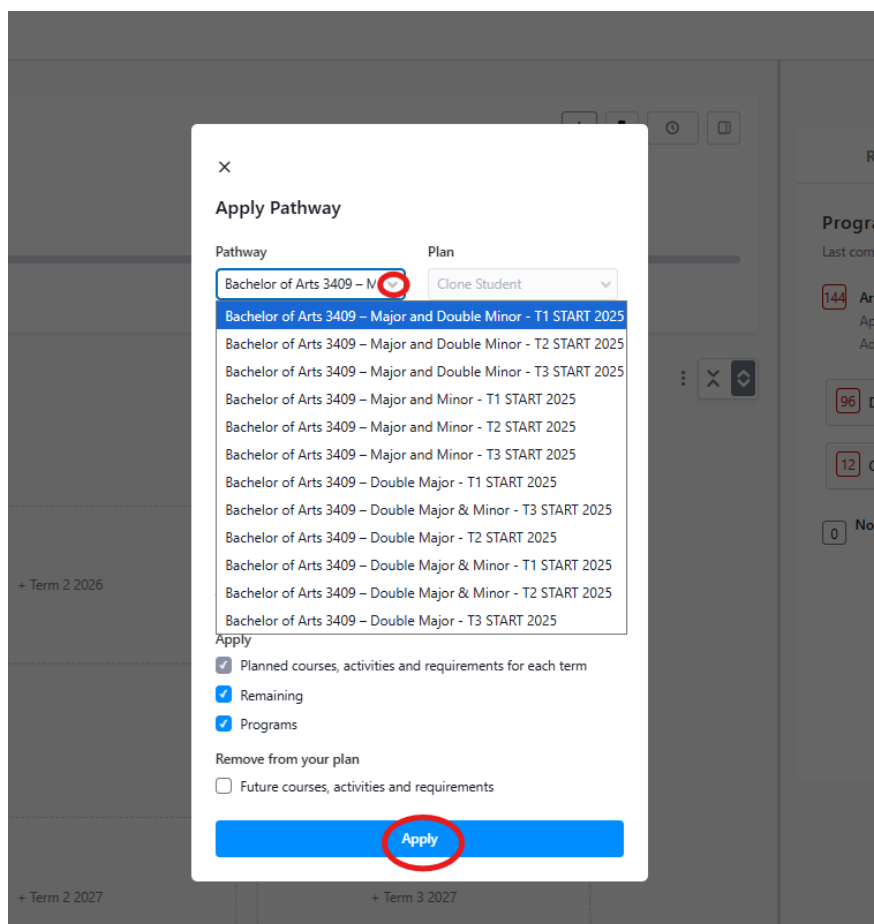
Select “Go to Planner” on the home page.

To see a list of your pathway options select the drop-down pathways menu.



Press "Apply" after selecting your pathway option.

For Multiple Pathway Options

Many programs have at least one recommended pathway, however, where multiple options are offered make sure you choose the pathway that applies to your correct start term. All pathways have been named:

Program name, program number, **Start Term**, Year

T1 – Term 1

T2 – Term 2

T3 – Term 3

For programs with multiple major or minor specialisations there may be multiple plans to choose from. Students can choose and remove pathways to try different options to help decide specialization choice. It is always recommended to consult the handbook to see rules on specialisation choices. To remove a plan if it doesn't suit desired progression – see instructions for removing a pathway on page 8.


Download a pathway

Students can download recommended pathway plans into PDF format. Select the three dots button in the pathway view to see the download pathway option.

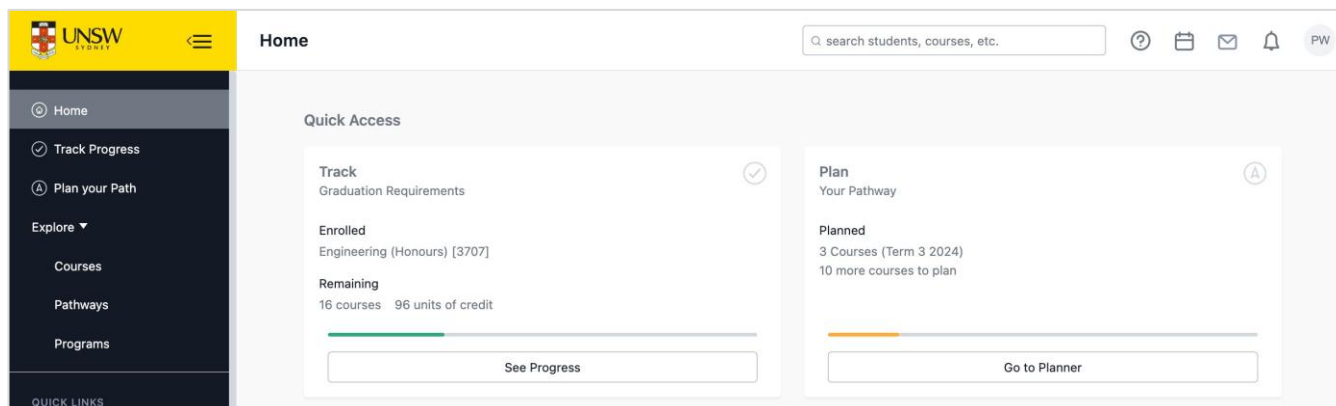

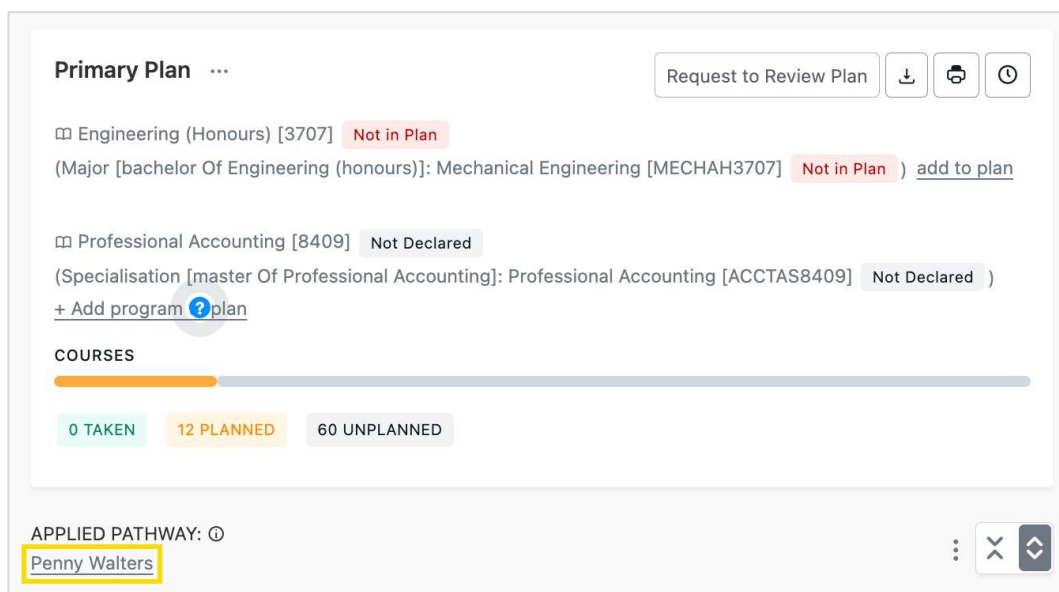
Remove a pathway

You can remove a pathway from your study plan if you later change your mind.

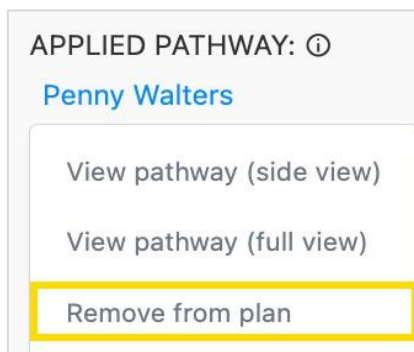
1. Select **Plan your Path** in the side menu or **Go to Planner** to access the Planner.



2. Select the **Pathway** hyperlink to view options.



3. Select **Remove from plan** to remove the pathway from your study plan.



The other options are:

- **View pathway (side view)** keeps you in the planner and shows you the pathway and the courses side-by-side. This allows you to drag across select courses without applying the entire pathway.
- **View pathway (full view)** takes you to the pathway template.

Select **OK** to confirm the removal of the pathway from your record.

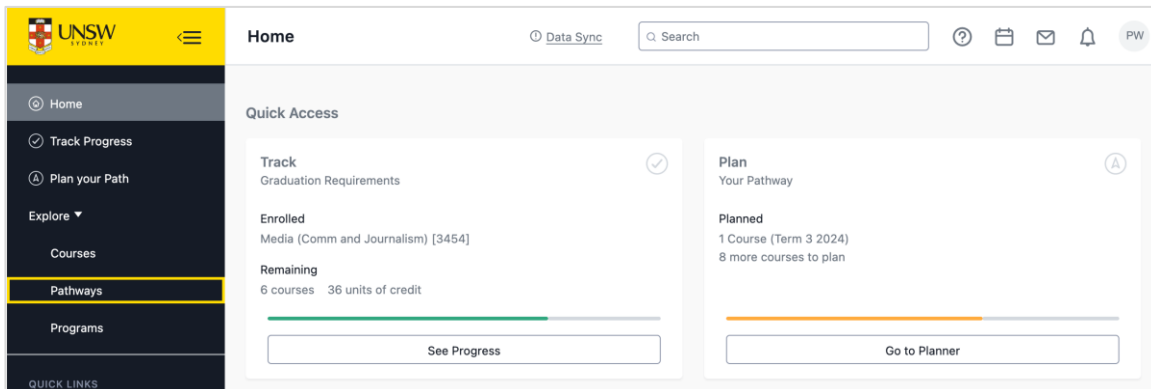

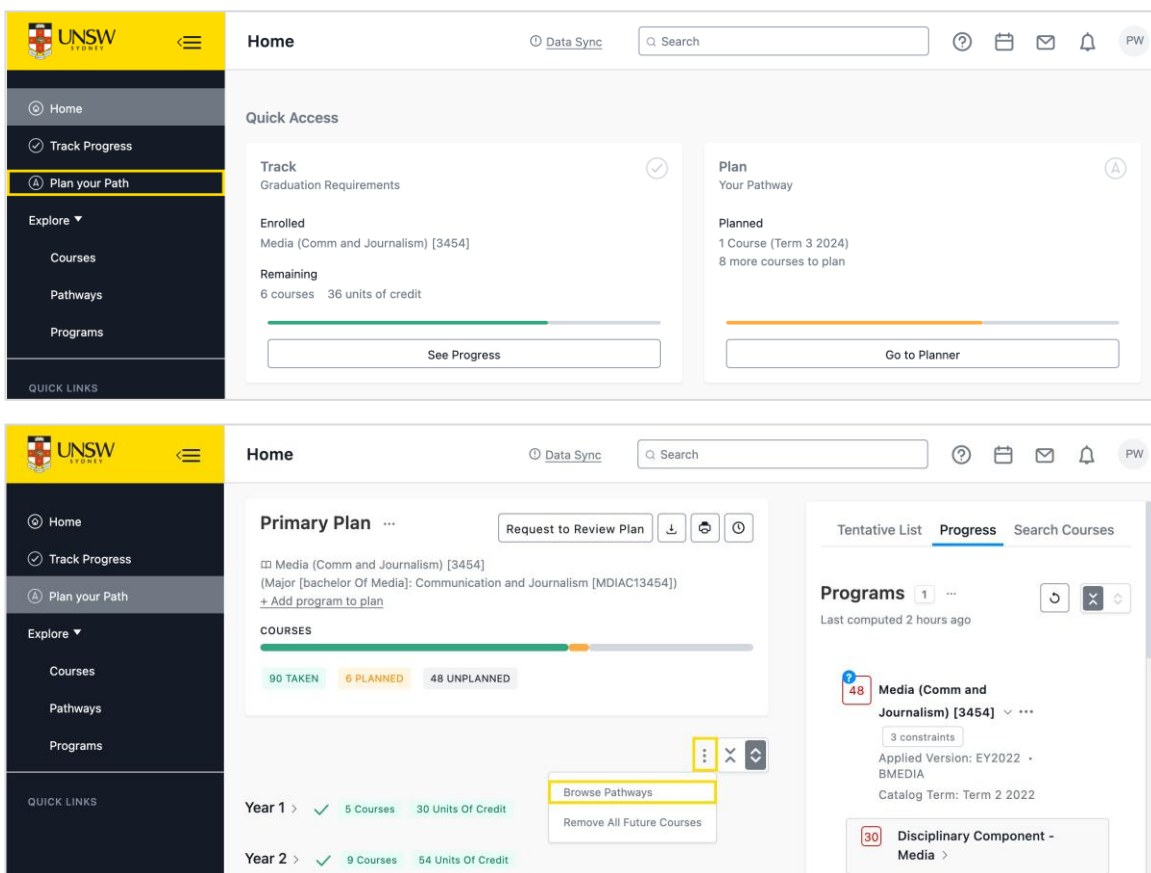
Browse pathways

You can create your own study plan from scratch or browse pathways and apply to your study plan. There are 3 ways to access pathways. These are:

1. Via **Explore > Pathways** in the side menu



2. Via **Plan your Path** in the side menu > **ellipsis icon** in the planner > **Browse Pathways**



3. Via **Go to Planner** in Quick Access links > **ellipsis icon** in the planner > **Browse Pathways**
