## Program and Course Terminology

Terminology	Definition
<b>Disciplinary Component</b>	Students must complete 132 Units of Credit (UOC) (22 courses) of Level 1 Core, Level 2 Core, Level 3 Core, and Prescribed Elective Courses to satisfy the core requirements of this degree.
<b>Level 1 Core Courses</b>	Students must complete 36 UOC (6 courses) of Level 1 Core Course.
<b>Level 2 Core Courses</b>	Students must complete 42 UOC (7 courses) of Level 2 Core Course.
<b>Level 3 Core Courses</b>	Students must complete 30 UOC (5 courses) of Level 3 Core Course.
<b>Prescribed Electives</b>	Students must complete 24 UOC (4 courses) of Elective Courses. Students can commence undertaking elective courses within their program after successfully completing 78 UOC.
<b>General Education</b>	Students must take 12 UOC (2 courses) of General Education (GENED) courses before Year 2. These must exclude any Medicine courses. Students should select GENED courses from the following humanities based faculties: DVC(E) Board of Studies; Faculty of Art & Design; Faculty of Built Environment; UNSW School of Business; Faculty of Arts & Social Sciences; Faculty of Law.
<b>Overall Program UOC</b>	Students must complete a minimum of 144 UOC (24 courses) across the Disciplinary Component and General Education courses to fulfil program requirements.
