The Bachelor of Design/Education is a four-year program for students intending to become secondary school teachers in either Visual Arts or both Visual Arts and Graphics & Multimedia Technology.

Students complete the Design component (120uoc) and the Education component (96uoc).

The courses that the student completes as part of their studio sequences, in the Design component, will form the 'subject content' for their chosen teaching area(s). For this reason, students must choose specific combinations of studio sequences to meet NESA accreditation requirements. **Please refer to the table on page 3 for information on the appropriate studio sequences for your chosen teaching area(s).**

The sample program on the following page shows you an example of how you might plan your enrolment. This should be adapted based on the availability and prerequisites of courses for your Design component.
