



Exchange Information for Criminology

UNSW offers students exciting Global Education opportunities in over 30 countries across Asia, North America, Europe and South America. The Student Exchange program allows you to study for one or two terms at an overseas partner university. All study taken on Student Exchange is pre-approved by your faculty and is part of your degree so no extra time is added onto your program. While on exchange you remain enrolled at UNSW and pay your normal UNSW tuition fees. There is no requirement to pay any additional tuition fees to the host institution. ELIGIBILITY

Criminology Applications

Prerequisite for Criminology exchange is **18 units of Criminology courses** prior to going on exchange. Any core CRIM/SOSS courses can be taken overseas and should be course matched in Endeavour.

Selection Process

Criminology exchanges are highly competitive with all applicants wishing to study at the same institution assessed relative to academic performance (WAM). Applicants therefore need to be flexible and be prepared to go on exchange to any one of their six preferences. A minimum credit average is required to be considered and applicants cannot have more than two fails across their program of study.

Application Deadlines:

April: Departing in Term 1 of the following year.

October: Departing in Term 3 of the following year

Recording exchange results

As grading systems are not completely comparable from one university to another, the results you attain at the exchange university are transferred on a pass or fail basis. If you fail a course while on exchange, or complete an unapproved course, the course will not count towards your studies at UNSW.
