All students in Advanced Science must complete an Honours year of 48 UoC.

In addition to the courses required for your major, students must also take *Science Electives*, *Free Electives*, and *General Education* courses. Students may use their Science Electives and/or Free Electives to complete a second major.

Science Electives are courses taken from within the Faculty of Science, as defined by *Table 1* in the Online Handbook.

Free Electives may be from Science or from any other Faculty at UNSW.

General Education courses cannot be Science courses, and Science students cannot take GEN_S courses for their General Education.

Recommended Electives are not required, but are recommended as complementary courses for this major when choosing electives.

Students cannot complete more than 72 UoC of Level 1 courses including any GEN courses and Level 1 courses taken for General Education.
