SECURITY / WHS

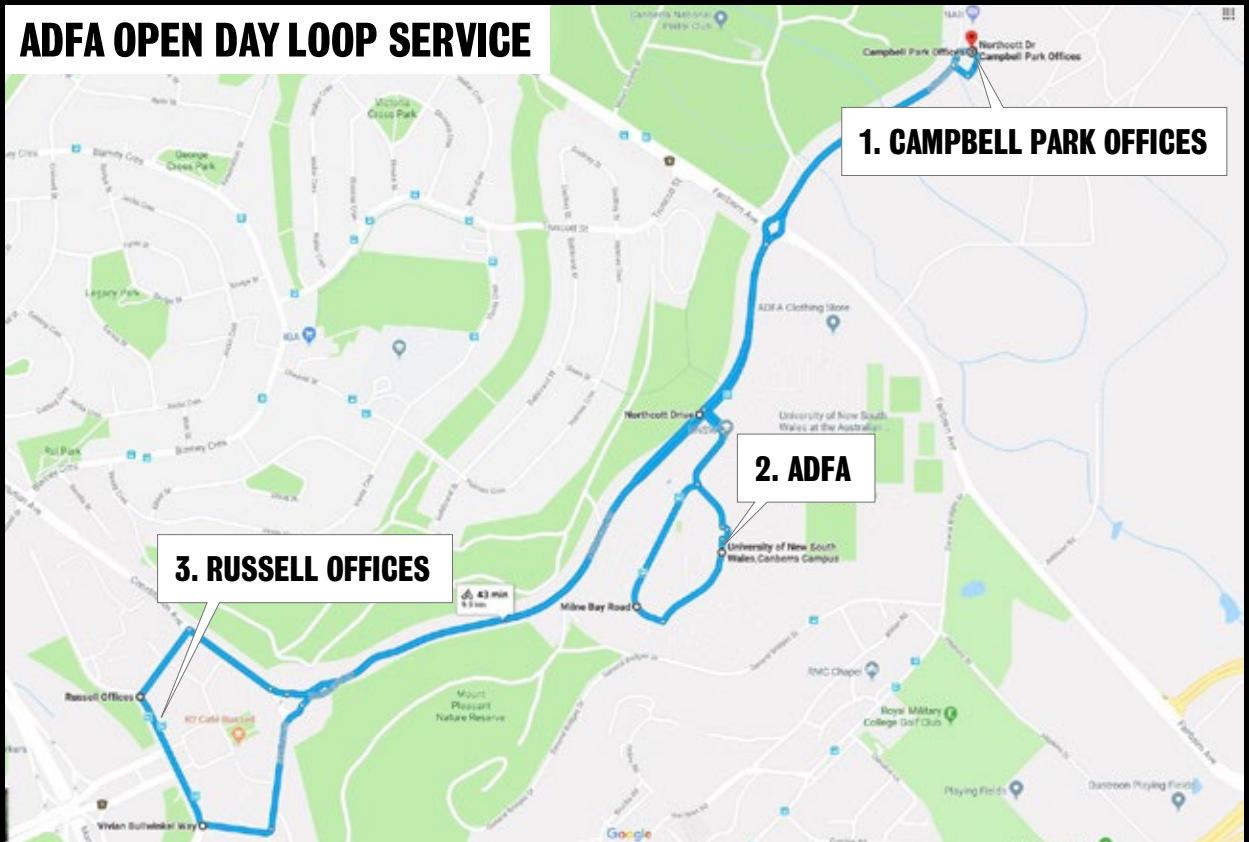

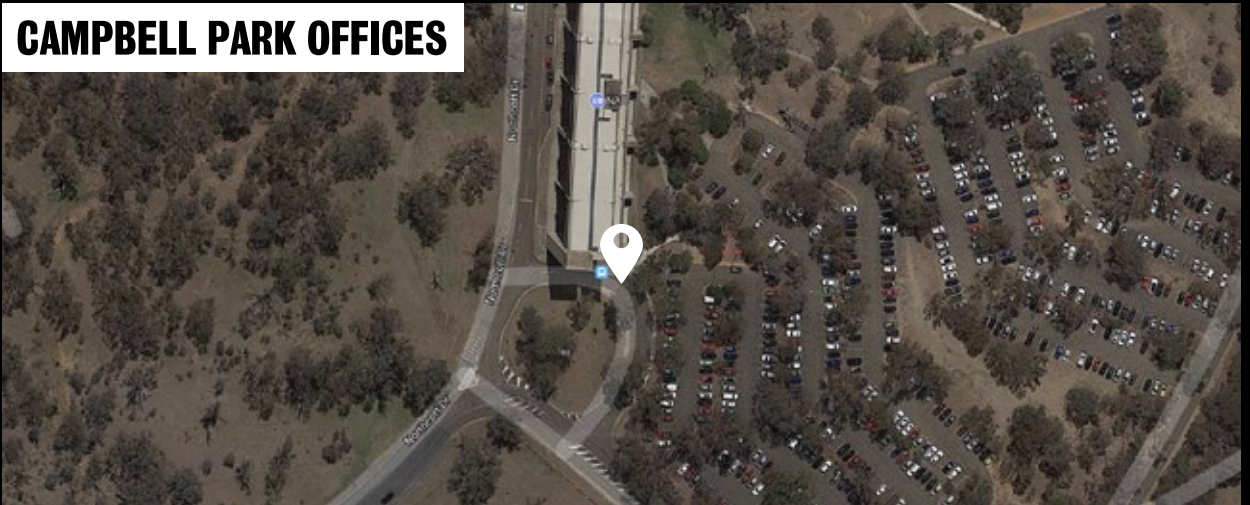
ADFA OPEN DAY LOOP SERVICE

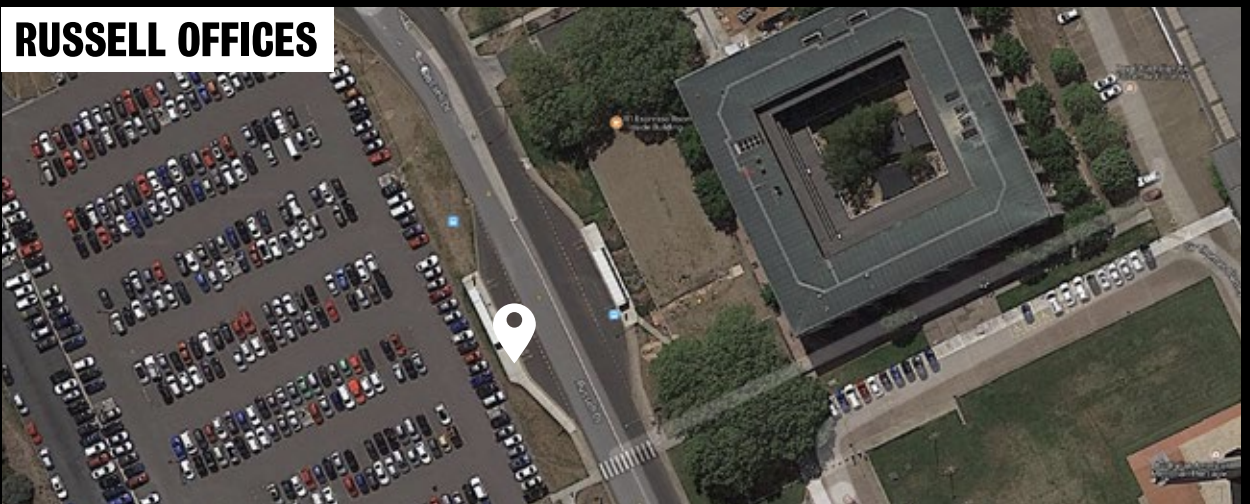

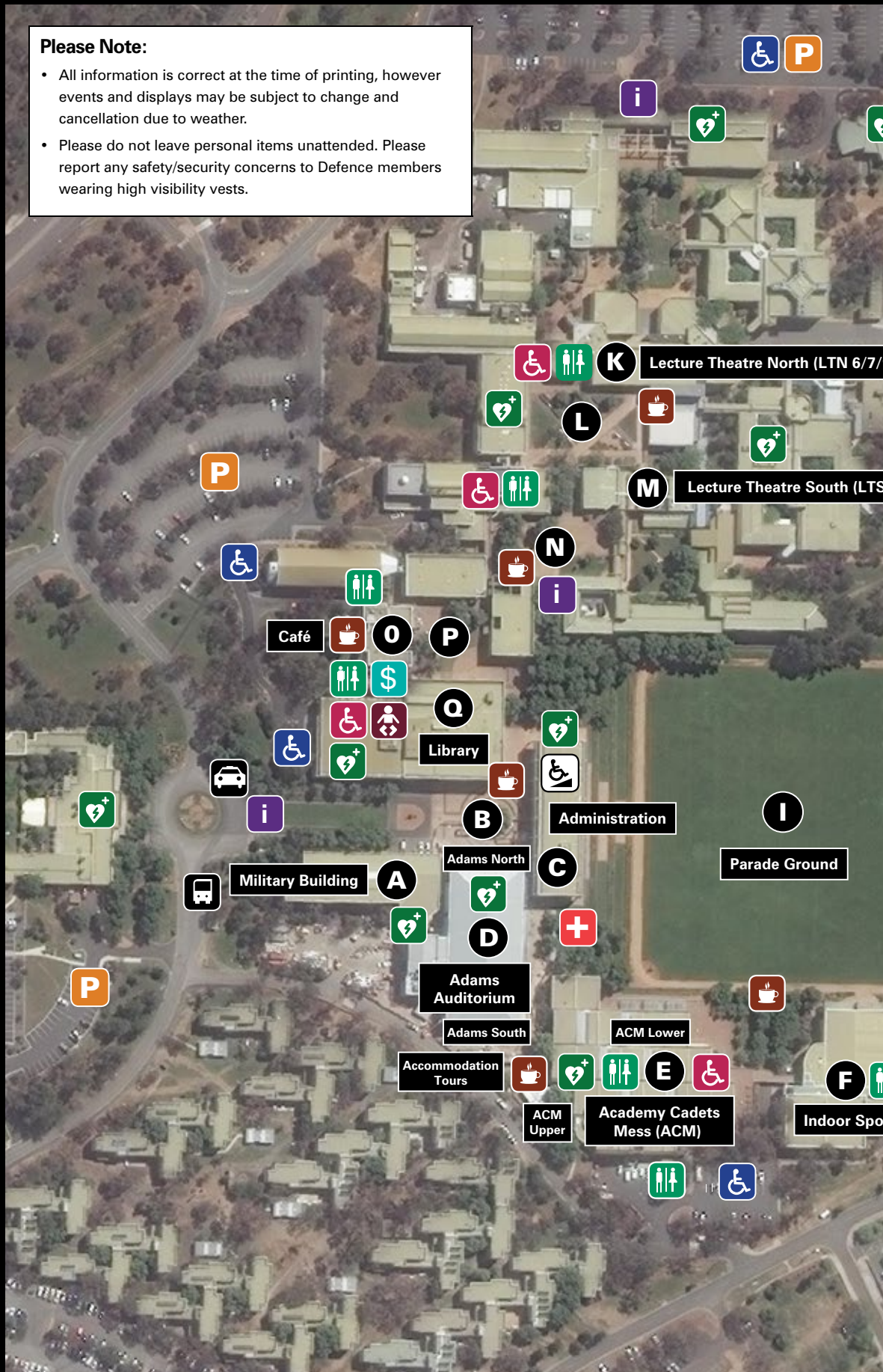
