SECURITY / WHS

Security and Work Health and Safety (WHS) at ADFA is everyone's responsibility. Whilst visiting ADFA you are required to adhere to the directions of the Australian Federal Police, Security, Defence and UNSW Canberra staff.

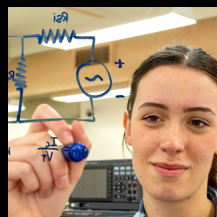

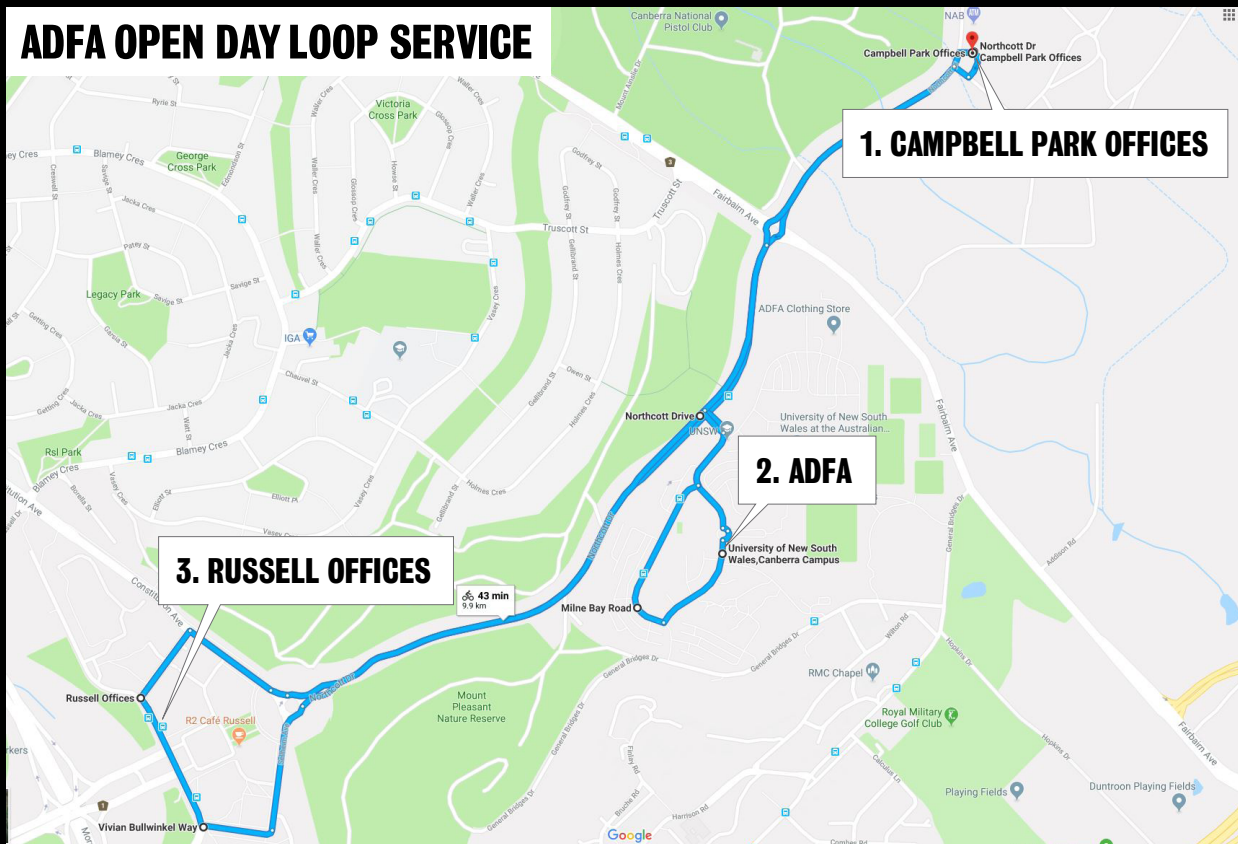

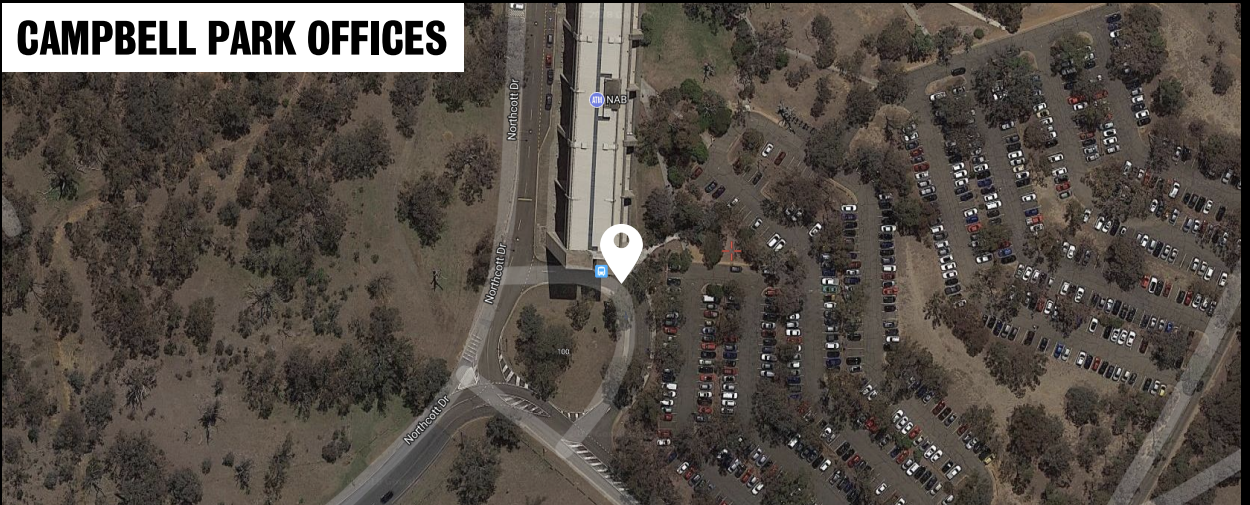
ADFA OPEN DAY LOOP SERVICE



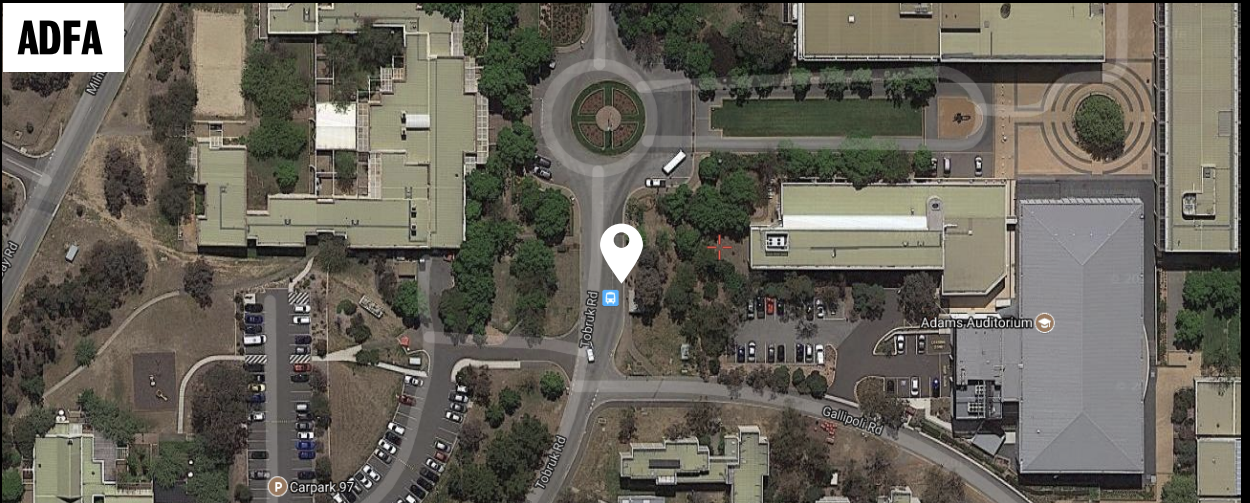
BUS SHUTTLE MAP

 **BUS SHUTTLE BUS PICK UP**

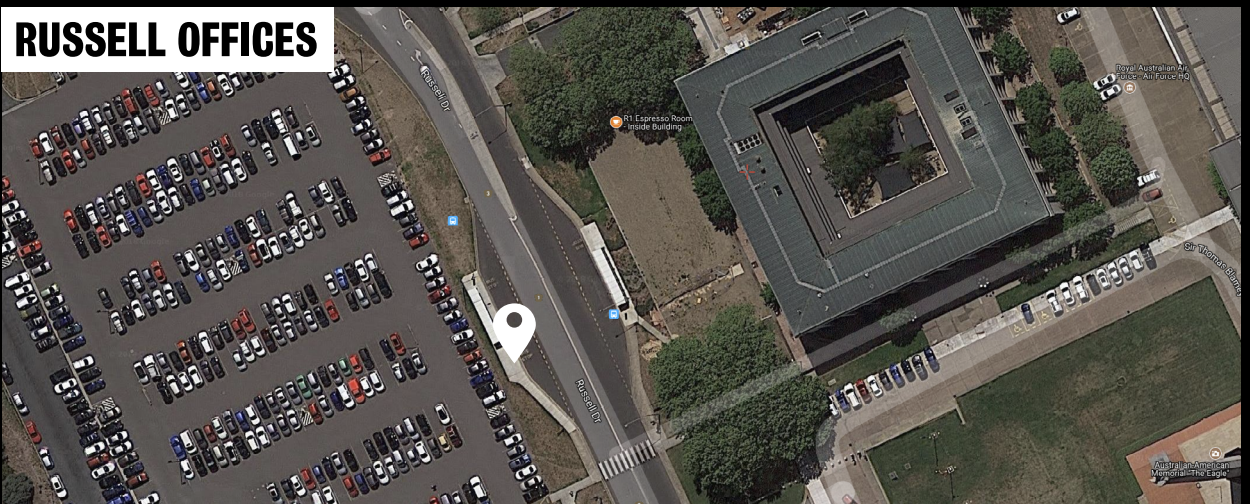

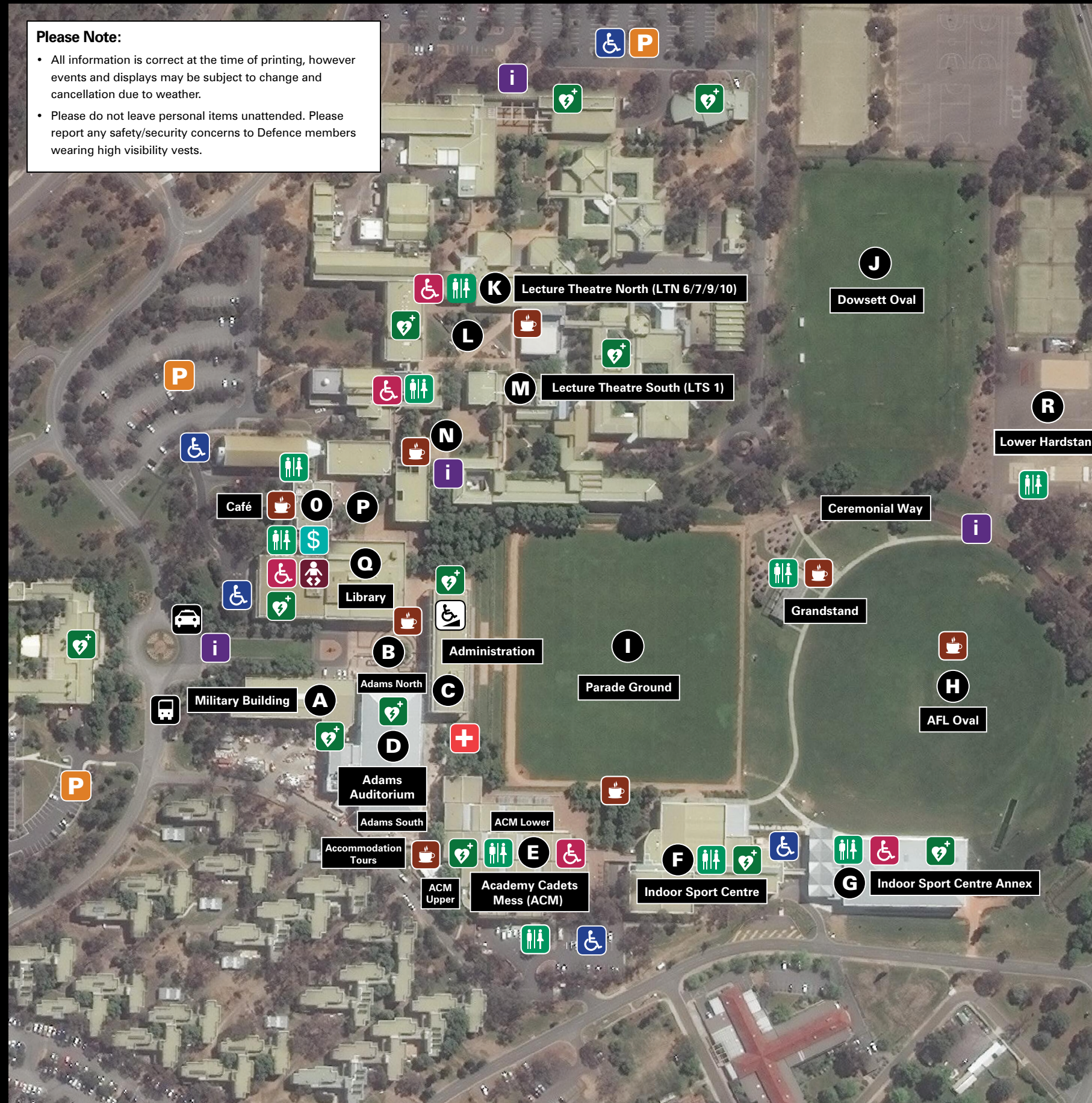
